In section 44141, add at the end the following:

(f) STATE AUDIT REQUIREMENT.—Beginning on the
 date that is 1 year after the date on which the amend ments made by this section take effect, and not less fre quently than annually thereafter, each State shall—

5 (1) conduct an independent and statistically
6 valid audit to determine the circumstances of indi7 viduals who—

8 (A) are otherwise eligible under a State 9 plan (or a waiver of such plan) under title XIX 10 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et 11 seq.) and who—

(i) met the requirement described in
section 1902(xx) of such Act, as added by
this section; or

(ii) were eligible for an exemption described in section 1902(xx) of such Act, as
added by this section; and

(B) were disenrolled from such State plan
(or waiver of such plan) as a result of this sec-

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tion (and the amendments made by this sec tion); and

3 (2) not later than 180 days after each such
4 audit is completed, submit to the Secretary of
5 Health and Human Services, and make publicly
6 available, the results of such audit.

7 (g) CONDITIONAL EFFECTIVENESS.—This section 8 (and the amendments made by this section) shall not 9 apply with respect to a State plan (or waiver of such plan) under title XIX of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 10 1396 et seq.) if more than 5 percent of the individuals 11 12 who were disenrolled from such State plan (or a waiver) as a result of this section (and the amendments made by 13 14 this section) are otherwise eligible individuals who—

(1) met the requirement described in section
16 1902(xx) of such Act, as added by this section; or
(2) were eligible for an exemption described in
section 1902(xx) of such Act, as added by this section.

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
