SEC CONDITIONAL EFFECTIVENESS.
Any provision of this subtitle (including any amend-
ment made by this subtitle) shall cease to have force or
effect if such provision (or amendment) results in—
(1) reduced eligibility under a State plan (or
waiver of such plan) under title XIX of the Social
Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.) for children
(including children with disabilities or other special
health care needs);
(2) reduced enrollment under such a State plan
(or waiver of such plan) of such children;
(3) reduced benefits provided under such a
State plan (or waiver of such plan) to such children;
(4) increased cost-sharing requirements under
such a State plan (or waiver of such plan) for such
children; or
(5) reduced Federal financial participation
under such a State plan (or waiver of such plan)
with respect to benefits furnished to such children.
