4 (a) CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY FOR DEEMED
5 NEWBORNS UNTIL AGE 6.—

6 (1) MEDICAID.—Section 1902(e)(4) of the So-7 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(e)(4)) is amended by striking "one year" and inserting "6 years". 8 9 (2) CHIP.—Section 2112(e) of the Social Secu-10 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1397ll(e)) is amended by strik-11 ing "1 year of age" and inserting "6 years of age 12 (except that such a child who is enrolled under the 13 State child health plan or waiver may be transferred 14 to the Medicaid program under title XIX for the re-15 maining duration of the 6-year continuous eligibility 16 period, if the child becomes eligible for full benefits 17 under title XIX during such period)".

7	(B) in the text preceding subparagraph
8	(A), by inserting "has attained the age of 6
9	and" after "an individual who";
10	(C) in subparagraph (A), by striking "the
11	12-month period" and inserting "the 24-month
12	period";
13	(D) by redesignating subparagraphs (A)
14	through (C) as clauses (i) through (iii), respec-
15	tively, and adjusting the margins accordingly;
16	and
17	(E) by striking "The State plan" and in-
18	serting
19	"(A) CHILDREN UNDER AGE 6.—The State
20	plan (or waiver of such State plan) shall pro-
21	vide that an individual who is under the age of
22	6 and who is determined to be eligible for bene-
23	fits under a State plan (or waiver of such plan)
24	approved under this title under subsection

1	(a)(10)(A) shall remain eligible for such bene-
2	fits until the earlier of—
3	"(i) the time that such individual at-
4	tains the age of 6; or
5	"(ii) the date that such individual
6	ceases to be a resident of such State.
7	"(B) CHILDREN AGES 6 THROUGH 18.—
8	The State plan".
9	(2) CHIP.—Section $2107(e)(1)(K)$ of the So-
10	cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. $1397gg(e)(1)(K)$ ) is
11	amended—
12	(A) by striking "1 year of"; and
13	(B) by striking "12-month" and inserting
14	"applicable".
15	(c) Updating Contact Information During
16	Continuous Eligibility Period.—
17	(1) Medicaid.—Section 1902(a) of the Social
18	Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)) is amended—
19	(A) in paragraph (86), by striking "and"
20	at the end;
21	(B) in paragraph (87), by striking the pe-
22	riod at the end and inserting "; and"; and
23	(C) by inserting after paragraph (87) the
24	following new paragraph:
25	"(88) provide for a process—

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1	"(A) to obtain, not less frequently than an-
2	nually, the up-to-date contact information for
3	individuals enrolled under such plan (or a waiv-
4	er of such plan) who have been so enrolled for
5	a period of longer than 12 months pursuant to
6	a continuous eligibility provision under this
7	title; and
8	"(B) to inform each such individual of
9	their enrollment under such plan (or waiver)
10	pursuant to such continuous eligibility provision
11	and of the remaining duration of the applicable
12	period of continuous eligibility.".
13	(2) CHIP.—Section $2107(e)(1)$ of the Social
14	Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1397gg(e)(1)) is amended—
15	(A) by redesignating subparagraphs (H)
16	through (U) as subparagraphs (I) through (V),
17	respectively; and
18	(B) by inserting after subparagraph (G)
19	the following new subparagraph:
20	"(H) Section 1902(a)(88) (relating to the
21	verification of contact information and provision
22	of information regarding enrollment during a
23	period of continuous eligibility).".

(d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 this section shall take effect on the date that is 1 year
 after the date of the enactment of this section.

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
