At the end of the bill, add the following:

12	(1) Unfair or deceptive acts or prac-
13	TICES.—A violation of subsection (a) or a regulation
14	promulgated under such subsection shall be treated
15	as a violation of a regulation under section
16	18(a)(1)(B) of the Federal Trade Commission Act
17	(15 U.S.C. 57a(a)(1)(B)) regarding unfair or decep-
18	tive acts or practices.

(2) Powers of commission.—The Federal
Trade Commission shall enforce subsection (a) and
the regulations promulgated under such subsection
in the same manner, by the same means, and with
the same jurisdiction, powers, and duties as though
all applicable terms and provisions of the Federal
Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 41 et seq.) were
incorporated into and made a part of this Act. Any
person who violates such subsection or a regulation
promulgated under such subsection shall be subject
to the penalties and entitled to the privileges and
immunities provided in the Federal Trade Commis-
sion Act.
