2 Resources of the Senate a report on the efficacy of State  
3 energy security plans that includes—

4           (1) an evaluation of whether and how State en-  
5 ergy security plans have improved the ability of  
6 States to identify, assess, and mitigate risks to en-  
7 ergy infrastructure and supply chains and to plan  
8 for, respond to, and recover from events that disrupt  
9 energy supply;

10           (2) recommendations for—

11               (A) improving the ability of States de-  
12 scribed in paragraph (1); and

13               (B) actions the Secretary of Energy may  
14 take to improve coordination with States with  
15 respect to identifying, assessing, and mitigating  
16 risks to energy infrastructure and supply chains  
17 and planning for, responding to, and recovering  
18 from events that disrupt energy supply;

19           (3) information on Federal financial assistance  
20 made available to States under part D of title III of  
21 the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C.  
22 6321 et seq.) that was used to implement State en-  
23 ergy security plans;

24           (4) information on activities carried out by  
25 States using such financial assistance;

1           (5) an analysis of the efficacy of the implemen-  
2           tation of section 366 of the Energy Policy and Con-  
3           servation Act (42 U.S.C. 6326), as amended by this  
4           Act; and

5           (6) information on State use of assistance pro-  
6           vided under section 366(f) of the Energy Policy and  
7           Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6326(f)) (as amended  
8           by this Act), including any revisions of State energy  
9           security plans made by States resulting from assist-  
10          ance provided under such section 366(f).

11          (b) PROTECTED INFORMATION.—The report required  
12          under subsection (a) shall be submitted in a form that  
13          may be made available to the public, except that any infor-  
14          mation protected from disclosure under section 366(h) of  
15          the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C.  
16          6326(h)) shall be included in the report in an annex that  
17          shall not be publicly disclosed, consistent with such sec-  
18          tion.

19          (c) STATE ENERGY SECURITY PLAN DEFINED.—In  
20          this section, the term “State energy security plan” has  
21          the meaning given such term in section 366(a) of the En-  
22          ergy Policy and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6326(a)).
