Page 5, beginning on line 7, strike “or to have acted in willful disregard” and insert “or to have knowledge fairly implied on the basis of objective circumstances”.

Page 13, strike line 10 and all that follows through page 14, line 4 and insert the following:

1 SEC. 106. RELATIONSHIP TO STATE LAWS.

2 The provisions of this title shall preempt any State
3 law, rule, or regulation only to the extent that such State
4 law, rule, or regulation conflicts with a provision of this
5 title. Nothing in this title may be construed to prohibit
6 any State from enacting or enforcing a law, rule, or regu-

Page 31, strike line 22 and all that follows through page 32, line 12 and insert the following:

12 State law, rule, or regulation conflicts with a provision of

1 this subtitle. Nothing in this subtitle may be construed
2 to prohibit any State from enacting or enforcing a law,

4 dren or teens than the provision of this subtitle.

Page 40, strike line 15 and all that follows through
page 41, line 9 and insert the following:

5 **SEC. 237. RELATIONSHIP TO STATE LAW.**

8 State law, rule, or regulation conflicts with a provision of
9 this subtitle. Nothing in this subtitle may be construed

page 43, line 11 and insert the following:
