**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Energy and Commerce Committee will hold a markup on Wednesday, March 25, 2026, at 10:15 a.m. (ET) in 2123 Rayburn House Office Building, and subsequent days as necessary, to consider the following items:

- H.R. 7386, The First Responder Network Authority Reauthorization Act (Reps. Dunn and McClellan)
- H.R. 7022, Mystic Alerts Act (Reps. Pfluger and Fletcher)

**II. LEGISLATION**

**A. H.R. 7386, The First Responder Network Authority Reauthorization Act (Reps. Dunn and McClellan)**

This bill would reauthorize the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet) for 10 years and would place it directly under control of the National Telecommunications and Information Administration. It would also make changes to leadership positions and components of the National Public Safety Broadband Network, and includes provisions to increase transparency, ensure accountability, and strengthen FirstNet. On February 10, 2026, the Subcommittee on Communications and Technology forwarded the bill to the Full Committee by voice vote.

**B. H.R. 7022, Mystic Alerts Act (Reps. Pfluger and Fletcher)**

This bill would require the Federal Communications Commission to issue a rulemaking establishing standards and protocols to facilitate satellite alerting capabilities for commercial mobile service providers that transmit emergency alerts. On January 15,

2026, the Subcommittee on Communications and Technology forwarded the bill to the Full Committee by voice vote.
