## A BILL

To reauthorize the Technology-enabled Collaborative  
Learning Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Accelerating Access  
5 to Dementia and Alzheimer’s Provider Training Act” or  
6 the “AADAPT Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANDING CAPACITY FOR HEALTH OUTCOMES.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 330N of the Public  
3 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 254c–20) is amended—

4 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by striking “entities”  
5 and inserting “entities, including a public or non-  
6 profit private entity,”; and

7 (2) in subsection (b), by inserting “dementia  
8 care,” after “palliative care,”.

9 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section  
10 330N(k) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.  
11 254c–20(k)) is amended by striking “fiscal years 2022  
12 through 2026” and inserting “fiscal years 2027 through  
13 2031”.
