Howard R. Sklamberg, J.D.

Mr. Sklamberg is the Deputy Commissioner for Global Regulatory Operations and Policy at the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). He provides executive oversight, strategic leadership, and policy direction to FDA's domestic and international product quality and safety efforts, including global data-sharing, development and harmonization of standards, field operations, compliance, regulatory and criminal enforcement activities. Mr. Sklamberg has also served as the Director of the Office of Compliance at FDA's Center for Drug Evaluation and Research; the Deputy Associate Commissioner for Regulatory Affairs in the Office of Regulatory Affairs (ORA); and the Director of ORA's Office of Enforcement. Before joining FDA in [insert], Mr. Sklamberg served as Deputy Chief of the Fraud and Public Corruption Section in the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Columbia, as an Assistant U.S. Attorney in that office, and as a trial attorney in the Justice Department's Public Integrity Section. He is an adjunct professor at American University's Washington College of Law where he teaches courses on congressional investigations and white-collar crime. Mr. Sklamberg graduated from Harvard Law School, received a bachelor's degree in economics and political science from Yale University, and earned a master's degree from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy.
