Amount: As the prime contractor, AHIP received since October 1, 2011 approximately \$20 million for a multi-site research contract with the CDC. The vast majority of the \$20 million was passed on to subcontracted research centers. AHIP's share of the contract revenue amounted to far less than 10% of the organization's revenue received for the applicable year.
