Testimony for the hearing entitled “PPACA Enrollment and the Insurance Industry” (the “Hearing”) on May 7, 2014 is being provided on behalf of Health Care Service Corporation, a Mutual Legal Reserve Company (“HCSC”) as HCSC is the entity engaged in the business that is the subject matter of the Hearing.

5. The witness has not personally received any Federal grants or contracts (including subgrants or subcontracts) from the Federal Government on or after October 1, 2011. The following are Federal contracts to which HCSC is a party. Four of HCSC’s wholly owned subsidiaries (HCSC Insurance Services Company (“HISC”), GHS Health Maintenance Organization, Inc. d/b/a BlueLincs HMO (“BlueLincs”), AHS-Tulsa Oklahoma Health Plan, Inc. (“AHS”) and GHS Insurance Company f/k/a/ GHS Property and Casualty Insurance Company, who are not represented at this Hearing, are parties to separate contracts with CMS related to prescription drug programs, which are not listed below.

- CMS contract H0927 – Medicare-Medicaid Plan (MMAI) - three-way contract with CMS & IL Medicaid agency Healthcare and Family Services (dated 11/12/13)
- CMS contract S5743 – Prescription Drug Plan – Joint Enterprise contract with Northern Plains Alliance (HCSC is a party effective 7/31/13)
- OPM contract CS 2929 – Federal Employee Health Benefits Plan Standard Contract for Community-Rated HMO (effective 1/1/2013)
- OPM Contract OPM-01-FEDVIP-01AP-6 for Federal Employee Dental and Vision Insurance Program – OPM Contracts with the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association (“BCBSA”), who contracts with HCSC in its service areas (effective 1/1/2014)

- OPM contract for Multi-State Plan Program - authorized under ACA section 1334, contracted through the BCBSA, who contracts with HCSC as a Plan Participant to provide benefits to members in its designated service area (effective 1/1/14)
- HHS Indian Health Service (“IHS”) Contract Health Services – Fiscal Intermediary contract HHSP2332010000ZIC
- Veterans Health Administration (“VHA”) Patient-Centered Community Care (PC3) contract with TriWest Healthcare Alliance (“TriWest”) – HCSC contracts with TriWest to offer a network of providers and associated network services within HCSC’s designated service areas (effective 2013)
- HCSC contracts with several federal government contractors to offer insured or third party administrative services for the provision of health benefits to such government contractors, and in this context may be considered Federal Subcontractors. HCSC contracts with the following government contractors in this capacity:

- HCSC supports the administration of Office of Personnel Management (“OPM”) contract CS 1039 – Federal Employee Health Benefits Plan (FFS Carrier) – OPM contracts with the BCBSA who contracts with HCSC as a Plan Participant to administer the FEP benefits to members in HCSC’s BCBSA licensed service areas (effective 1960 to present)
