Before that, Dr. Cohen was the Director of Stakeholder Engagement for the CMS Innovation Center, where she worked with the Innovation Center's many stakeholders to identify and test new payment and care delivery models. Dr. Cohen graduated from Cornell University, received her medical degree from Yale University, a Masters in Public Health from Harvard, and trained in Internal Medicine at the Massachusetts General Hospital.
