As Deputy Inspector General for the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Office of Inspector General (OIG), Office of Audit Services, Ms. Jarmon directs the efforts of over 600 auditors, analysts, and other professional and technical staff in about 40 locations nationwide. She is responsible for providing comprehensive audit services for all HHS programs(over \$1 trillion); overseeing non-Federal audit activity, including conducting quality control reviews of audits of State and local governments, colleges and universities, and nonprofit organizations; and overseeing HHS's annual financial statement audits conducted under the Chief Financial Officers Act and HHS's annual Federal Information Security Management Act audits.

Prior to joining HHS OIG, Ms. Jarmon held a variety of managerial and executive positions in both the public and private sectors. She held Senior Executive positions in the Federal government including over 15 years with the Government Accountability Office (GAO) and several years with the U.S. Department of Education and the U.S. Capitol Police. Earlier in her career, Ms. Jarmon was a senior audit manager with KPMG and worked in their Washington, DC and Norfolk offices. She specialized in financial audits of colleges and universities, state and local government entities, and other types of nonprofits. She also taught statistical auditing and other audit training courses as part of the firm's training program.

Ms. Jarmon has received numerous awards and recognition throughout her career. She was recognized by the AICPA in the "Journal of Accountancy" as a Trailblazer in an article on "Profiles of Success". She has also received career awards including GAO's highest award, the Comptroller General's Award for outstanding leadership skills, GAO's Human Resources Management award, and HHS's Secretary's Award for Meritorious Service.
