## Luciana Borio, M.D.

Dr. Luciana Borio is the Acting Chief Scientist at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA). In this capacity, Dr. Borio leads and coordinates FDA's cross-cutting scientific and public health efforts, including the Advancing Regulatory Science Initiative and the Medical Countermeasures Initiative (MCMi). In addition, Dr. Borio provides leadership and support for the broad portfolio of activities overseen by the Office of the Chief Scientist.

After receiving her M.D. from the George Washington University, Dr. Borio completed her residency in internal medicine at the New York Presbyterian Hospital - Cornell Medical Center as well as a combined fellowship in infectious diseases (at Johns Hopkins University) and critical care medicine (at the National Institutes of Health). She continues to practice medicine at Johns Hopkins Hopkins Hospital.

Dr. Borio served as assistant professor of medicine at Johns Hopkins University, senior associate at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center – Center for Biosecurity, and advisor on biodefense programs for the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Dr. Borio joined FDA as a medical reviewer and then served as FDA's Assistant Commissioner for Counterterrorism Policy and Director of its Office of Counterterrorism and Emerging Threats. Dr. Borio played a key role in FDA's response to the 2014 West Africa Ebola epidemic and continues to oversee its preparedness and response activities for emerging threats.
