Professor Marci A. Hamilton is the Founder and CEO of CHILD USA, the think tank whose mission is to employ in-depth legal analysis and cutting-edge social science research to protect children, prevent future abuse and neglect, and bring justice to survivors. She is also a Professor of Practice in the Department of Political Science and a Fox Family Pavilion Senior Fellow in the Program for Research on Religion at the University of Pennsylvania. Professor Hamilton is the leading expert on clergy sex abuse, child sex abuse statutes of limitation ("SOL"), and reforms needed for institution-based abuse. She is the author of Justice Denied: What America Must Do to Protect Its Children (Cambridge University Press), which makes the case for the elimination of child sex abuse statutes of limitation, numerous articles in law reviews and peer-reviewed journals, and countless pro bono amicus briefs for victims of sex abuse. She has been honored by Pennsylvania's Governor as a Distinguished Daughter of Pennsylvania, received many other awards for her public interest work and leadership, and is a frequent commentator for the media.
