

James Erwin is Federal Affairs Manager for Telecommunications at Americans for Tax Reform and the Executive Director of Digital Liberty, positions he assumed in August 2022. He previously worked four years for Senator Susan Collins on the Senate Aging Committee and in her personal office, covering a diverse portfolio of domestic policy issues that included telecommunications and technology, banking, trade, Social Security, education, energy, and several others.
