Greg Garcia is the Executive Director of the Health Sector Coordinating Council Cybersecurity Working Group, the government-recognized critical infrastructure industry advisory council of more than 460 healthcare providers, pharmaceutical and medtech companies, payers and health IT entities partnering with government to identify and mitigate cyber threats to health data and research, systems, manufacturing and patient care.

Garcia was appointed by President George W. Bush as the nation's first Assistant Secretary for Cybersecurity and Communications for the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. Throughout his 32-year career in national service he has influenced and implemented change at the intersection of business, public policy and national security, including executive leadership roles in healthcare, financial services, high technology and the United States Congress.
