Clinical, Technological, and Scientific Innovations

Mindful Moods Smartphone App

- 2014 – 2015 Developed an Apple and Android smartphone app to assess PHQ-9 symptoms of depression, including suicidality, and demonstrated feasibility and acceptability in a small clinical study. Study results were published, invited for presentation at Apple, and offer one of the earlier examples of how smartphones can safely assess safety in mental health patients.

App Evaluation

- 2014 – I created the first clinical guidance for the evaluation of mental health smartphone apps to be endorsed by a major medical society (American Psychiatric Association). This guidance has been adopted by local Hospitals (CHA), taught internationally, offered in numerous national CMEs, published in Lancet Digital Health and World Psychiatry, supported by NIMH contracts, and currently forming as a national committee sponsored by the APA. In 2019, I chaired a 2-day meeting on the topic, inviting 12 experts from around the country (including 3 patients) that was hosted by the American Psychiatric Association in Washington DC. In 2020, the project was selected for a presentation by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) at its annual privacy convention. In 2021 the project expanded as mindapps.org and is now the largest open database of apps and used in medical student and resident education.

LAMP

- 2014 – I created the LAMP smartphone platform composed of Apple and Android smartphone apps, a custom API, and a custom database to enable digital clinical care and research. The app is currently used in the BIDMC Digital Psychiatry Clinic and DOORs programs as well as many NIMH-sponsored studies. Boston University is using the app for a research study with 200 students, University of Montreal for a research studies with 20 patients with schizophrenia, Cal. State Northridge in Los Angeles for a study with 200 students, the BIDMC Department of Anesthesia for a study on post-operative recovery, the BIDMC Department of Cognitive Neurology for a study on early course dementia, and a university in China as well. In 2021 the app was selected by the NIH as part of the AMP SZ study and is used today in the world’s largest digital phenotyping study.

Digital Phenotyping

2015 – I was first author of the paper that defined the term ‘digital phenotyping’ which has since become a topic of global interest across healthcare. I have presented on this topic at international meetings and published further papers in international journals.

Digital Clinic

2018 – Created the first digital mental health clinic that uses smartphone technology to augment and extend outpatient care. The basis for this new model of care was published in npj Digital Medicine and in 2023 was featured in NEJM-Catalyst. The model has since been adopted by other medical centers around the country. Published papers show this model can enable patients to achieve rapid improvement in depression and anxiety within 6 weeks, which enables more patient throughput to increase access to care for more patients.

DOORS/Digital Navigator

2018 – Created a new digital health literacy program for patients with serious mental illness called DOORS, Digital Opportunities for Outcomes in Recover Services offered as a 4- and 6-week course. The training manual I created has been shared with Yale and the VA who are interested in offering DOORS, as well as the Los Angeles Department of Mental Health. The Digital Navigator role is a train-the-trainer model for DOORS but also expanded the role to clinical integration and tech engagement. It has been adopted by various systems already.
