

Joe Jobe is the Chief Executive Officer for the National Biodiesel Board (NBB). The NBB is the national trade association representing the biodiesel industry as the coordinating body for biodiesel research and development in the US. Its members include feedstock producers and processors, soybean commodity boards, biodiesel suppliers, and fuel marketers and distributors.

Joe has been with the NBB since 1997, and has served as CEO since January 1999. Joe's duties included serving as the principle investigator for the \$2.2 million biodiesel health effects testing program.
