

Richard R. Roldan

Richard (Rick) Roldan was named President and Chief Executive Officer of the National Propane Gas Association in March 2002. His tenure with NPGA began in 1995 with his appointment as Vice President of Government Relations. Since that time, Mr. Roldan has played an important role in the formulation of numerous federal laws and regulations that have saved the propane industry billions of dollars and strengthened its reputation as a clean, safe and reliable energy source.

NPGA is the national trade association of the propane industry. Its membership consists of approximately 3,000 companies, including producers, wholesalers, transporters, and retailer marketers of propane gas, as well as manufacturers and distributors of propane equipment and appliances. 60 million Americans use propane and 6 million households choose propane as their primary energy source.

Mr. Roldan's involvement with the propane gas industry began in 1994 with his selection as the founding Executive Director of the Propane Vehicle Council (PVC). The PVC was formed to promote propane as a cleaner-burning alternative transportation fuel.

From 1989 to 1993, Mr. Roldan served in the Administration of President George H. W. Bush as Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Interior for Land and Minerals Management. Mr. Roldan was one of the principal stewards of the nation's land, mineral and renewable resources. He also served on the staff of the White House Conference on Global Change.

He is co-author of Business PACs and Ideology: A Study of Contributions in the 1982 Election.

He is an active member of the Cathedral of Saint Matthew Parish, and is a past president of the parish council.

Mr. Roldan is a graduate of the University of Colorado, Boulder, where he was designated a 1977 CU Presidential Scholar.
