## **Ann F. Miles**

Ann Miles is the Director of the Office of Energy Projects. The Office is responsible for siting energy infrastructure projects including licensing, administration, and safety of non-federal hydropower projects; and authorization of interstate natural gas pipelines, gas storage facilities, and liquefied natural gas terminals. This includes review of applications to construct and operate hydropower and gas facilities, preparation of environmental documents, and recommendations to the Commission for action on the applications.

Ms. Miles joined the Commission in 1985. She has served in a number of managerial positions dealing primarily with licensing, compliance, and administration of hydropower projects. Most recently, she was Deputy Director of the Office of Energy Projects and before that Director of the Division of Hydropower Licensing.

Ms. Miles has a B.A. in French from Mary Baldwin College and an M.S. in Resource Management from the University of Maryland.
