Biography:

Jonathan Weisgall is Vice President for Legislative and Regulatory Affairs for Berkshire Hathaway Energy Company, a subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway. He joined CalEnergy (Berkshire Hathaway Energy's predecessor company) in 1993 as Vice President for Legislative and Regulatory Affairs. Weisgall also serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Center for Energy Efficiency and Renewable Technologies and Vice President of the Board of Directors of the Geothermal Energy Association. He is an Adjunct Professor of Law at Georgetown University Law Center, where he has taught a seminar on energy issues since 1990. Weisgall graduated from Columbia College and from Stanford Law School and previously practiced law in Washington, D.C. at Covington & Burling. He is also the author of *Operation Crossroads: The Atomic Tests at Bikini Atoll* (U.S. Naval Institute Press, 1994) and the executive producer of "Radio Bikini," which was nominated for an Academy Award for best documentary in 1988.
