

Ms. Cummings is the Interim Executive Director for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) at the Department of Transportation. In this position, she provides executive leadership over the administration and manages its daily operations to ensure strong integration among all program offices. She also provides broad guidance on operations and policy implementation of the full range of the Agency in support of the PHMSA Administrator.

A member of the Senior Executive Service since 2011, Ms. Cummings began her tenure with the Department of Transportation as the Executive Director for the Federal Railroad Administration.

Ms. Cummings received her Bachelor of Science in Business Logistics from Pennsylvania State University and holds a Master of Science in National Resource Strategy from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces along with a Master of Science in Management/Information Systems from the Florida Institute of Technology.

While with the Department of the Navy, Ms. Cummings gained expertise in logistics and maintenance programs, information technology, and engineering technical assistance programs. She also held several leadership positions where she provided strategic leadership and led stakeholder relationship management and strategic communications. Ms. Cummings has significant experience leading people, managing complex organizations, and overseeing multibillion-dollar financial operations.

Ms. Cummings is certified in both Program Management and Acquisition Logistics, is a graduate of the Naval Air Systems Command's Senior Executive Management Development Program, and is a member of the Defense Senior Leader Development Program 2010 cohort.

Significant awards received include the National Defense Industrial Association San Diego Chapter, Fleet Support Award; and the Navy Meritorious and Superior Civilian Service Awards.
