

Terry Dinan is a senior adviser in the Congressional Budget Office's Microeconomic Studies Division. She has written about a variety of environmental and energy issues, including the costs and effects of policies aimed at subsidizing energy sources and technologies, the budgetary effects of climate change, the design of climate-change policies and their implications for households and businesses in the United States, and the costs and consequences of renewable fuel standards and higher fuel-economy standards. She has testified before the Congress on those topics, published in a variety of professional journals, served as an associate editor for the *Journal of Environmental Economics and Management*, and served on the board of the Association of Environmental and Resource Economists.
