

Biography – Mr. Robert Corbin

Mr. Robert (Bob) Corbin is a 1979 graduate of the U.S. Coast Guard Academy and served over 22 years on active duty as a Coast Guard officer, retiring in 2001 with the rank of Commander. Upon retirement from active duty, Bob continued his public service career, joining the Federal civilian workforce as the Deputy Program Manager for the Coast Guard's liquefied natural gas deep water ports program.

In 2004, Bob joined the Department of Energy's Office of Fossil Energy, where he served as the Manager of the natural gas regulatory activities program in the Office of Oil and Natural Gas. He was appointed to the U.S. Government's Senior Executive Service in 2008 as the Director of Oil and Gas Global Security and Supply, where he was responsible for leading and managing Fossil Energy's natural gas regulatory activities, oil and natural gas international activities, and liquefied natural gas safety programs.

Bob assumed his current position as Deputy Assistant Secretary for the Office of Petroleum Reserves in 2013, with responsibility for providing executive leadership and program direction in the management and operation of the Department of Energy's Strategic Petroleum Reserve, Northeast Gasoline Supply Reserve, Northeast Home Heating Oil Reserve, and Naval Petroleum and Oil Shale Reserve.

Mr. Corbin holds Master's degrees in Chemical Engineering and Environmental Engineering from Tufts University and New Jersey Institute of Technology, respectively.
