Biography



David Trimble serves as a Director in the U.S. Government Accountability Office's Natural Resources & Environment group in Washington DC. Mr. Trimble provides leadership and oversight on US and International Nuclear Security and Cleanup issues. He previously led work on environmental issues including, controlling toxic substances, clean water and clean air issues, Superfund and EPA management.

Mr. Trimble joined the U.S. Government Accountability Office in April 2009. Previously Mr. Trimble worked for nine years at the Department of State's Political Military Affairs Bureau as the Director of the Office of Defense Trade Controls Compliance where he was the senior official responsible for export compliance and enforcement issues.
