## Thomas Ferguson CV

**Thomas E. Ferguson** has served as President and Chief Executive Officer of AZZ Incorporated since November 2013. Prior to joining AZZ, he served as Senior Vice President of Flowserve from December 2006 and as President of the Company's \$3.3 billion Flow Solutions Group from 2010-2012. Mr. Ferguson previously served as President of Flowserve Pump Division from 2003 to December 2009. He was President of Flow Solutions Division from 2000 to 2002, Vice President and General Manager of Flow Solutions Division North America from 1999 to 2000 and Vice President of Marketing and Technology for Flow Solutions Division from 1997 to 1999. He also served in a variety of marketing, sales, engineering and operational roles with BW/IP International, the predecessor to Flowserve. Prior to joining BW/IP in 1987 Mr. Ferguson held a variety of management positions in both manufacturing and oilfield service companies.

Mr. Ferguson graduated with a B.S. in Industrial Distribution from Texas A&M in 1978 and received an advanced executive management certificate from the University of Southern California in 1990. He is active in board work for several non-profit organizations, including Texas A&M University, Lionheart Children's Academies, and Haggai International.
