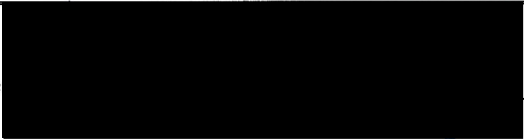

Mark Frigo

Mark Frigo is Vice President, Head of Energy Storage for E.ON in North America. In this capacity, Frigo is responsible for the division's business planning, personnel, and project development and execution. Frigo was lead on E.ON's successful endeavor to establish its first energy storage facility in Arizona, launching the company's efforts to bring reliable and efficient storage solutions to that region. His team has subsequently built two additional energy storage projects in Texas helping to stabilize the ERCOT grid.

Frigo has held numerous leadership roles within E.ON, previously serving as head of the Energy Marketing, Market Operations & Analysis, and Risk & Investment groups. His past accomplishments at E.ON include assisting with the implementation of a \$5.2 billion capital build program, helping raise approximately \$1 billion in tax equity for wind farms and \$107 million in U.S. Treasury Section 1603 grants for wind and solar projects, as well as successfully negotiating for major project contracts.

Prior to joining E.ON, Frigo served as a consultant at MWH Global, a global engineering and consulting firm focused on water and natural resources. During his tenure, Frigo founded the company's financial and management consulting business unit and provided services to financial institutions, multinational companies, and governments throughout the world. His previous experience also includes positions in business development and banking.

Frigo is a graduate of the University of Notre Dame and earned his Master of Business Administration from Pennsylvania State University.
