1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
This Act may be cited as the [" Act of
5 2018".]

1	SEC. 2. USE OF UNDERUTILIZED STRATEGIC PETROLEUM
2	RESERVE FACILITIES.
3	Section 168 of the Energy Policy and Conservation
4	Act (42 U.S.C. 6247a) is amended to read as follows:
5	"SEC. 168. USE OF UNDERUTILIZED FACILITIES.
6	"(a) Authority.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
7	sion of this title, the Secretary may establish and carry
8	out a program to lease underutilized Strategic Petroleum
9	Reserve storage facilities and related facilities to the pri-
10	vate sector, or a foreign government or its representative.
11	Petroleum products stored under this section are not part
12	of the Strategic Petroleum Reserve.
13	"(b) Protection of Facilities.—Any lease en-
14	tered into under the program established under subsection
15	(a) shall contain provisions providing for fees to fully com-
16	pensate the United States for all related costs of storage
17	and removals of petroleum products (including the propor-
18	tionate cost of replacement facilities necessitated as a re-
19	sult of any withdrawals) incurred by the United States
20	as a result of such lease.
21	"(c) Access by the United States.—The Sec-
22	retary shall ensure that leasing of facilities under the pro-
23	gram established under subsection (a) does not impair the
24	ability of the United States to withdraw, distribute, or sell
25	petroleum products from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve
26	in response to an energy emergency or to the obligations

of the United States under the Agreement on an International Energy Program. 3 "(d) NATIONAL SECURITY.—The Secretary shall ensure that leasing of facilities under the program established under subsection (a) to a foreign government or its 6 representative will not impair national security. 7 "(e) Deposits of Amounts Received.— "(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-8 9 graph (2), amounts received through the leasing of 10 facilities under the program established under sub-11 section (a) shall be deposited in the general fund of 12 the Treasury during the fiscal year in which such 13 amounts are received. 14 "(2) Costs.—The Secretary may use for costs 15 described in subsection (b), without further appro-16 priation, amounts received through the leasing of fa-17 cilities under the program established under sub-18 section (a).". 19 SEC. 3. PILOT PROGRAM TO LEASE STRATEGIC PETRO-20 LEUM RESERVE FACILITIES. 21 (a) In General.—Part B of title I of the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6231 et seq.) is

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amended by adding at the end the following:

1	"SEC. 170. PILOT PROGRAM TO LEASE STORAGE AND RE-
2	LATED FACILITIES.
3	"(a) Establishment.—In carrying out section 168
4	and not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
5	of the [Act of 2018], the Secretary shall
6	establish and carry out a pilot program to make available
7	for lease—
8	"(1) capacity for storage of up to 200,000,000
9	barrels of petroleum products at Strategic Petroleum
10	Reserve storage facilities; and
11	"(2) related facilities.
12	"(b) Contents.—In carrying out the pilot program
13	established under subsection (a), the Secretary shall—
14	"(1) identify appropriate Strategic Petroleum
15	Reserve storage facilities and related facilities to
16	lease, in order to make maximum use of such facili-
17	ties;
18	"(2) identify and implement any changes to fa-
19	cilities or facility operations necessary to so lease
20	such facilities, including any such changes necessary
21	to ensure the long-term structural viability and use
22	of the facilities for purposes of this part and part C;
23	"(3) make such facilities available for lease; and
24	"(4) identify environmental effects, including
25	benefits, of leasing storage facilities and related fa-
26	cilities.

1	"(c) Report.—Not later than 1 year after the date
2	of enactment of the [Act of 2018], the
3	Secretary shall submit to Congress a report on the status
4	of the pilot program established under subsection (a).".
5	(b) Conforming Amendment.—The table of con-
