The first woman to serve as president and CEO of ComEd, Illinois's largest utility company delivering electricity to 4 million customers in Chicago and Northern Illinois. Implemented the Energy Infrastructure Modernization Act, (also known as the Smart Grid Law), a multi-year, \$2.6 billion infrastructure modernization program and corresponding regulatory model redesign, resulting in record-breaking reliability and the highest customer satisfaction scores in the Company's 100-year history. Drove the 2016 passage of the Future Energy Jobs Act (FEJA), ground-breaking energy legislation aimed at growing renewable energy development in Illinois, creating thousands of clean energy jobs, significantly expanding funding for customer energy efficiency programs and providing millions of dollars in assistance for income-eligible customers.

Held primary accountability for ComEd's electric and customer operations and overall performance in the areas of operational, safety, reliability, financial, customer/key stakeholder and organizational effectiveness.
