**SUBJECT: Subcommittee Hybrid Hearing on “Oversight of DOE During the Covid-19 Pandemic”**

The Subcommittee on Energy of the Committee on Energy and Commerce will hold a hybrid hearing that includes both in person and remote attendance at **12 p.m. (EDT) on Tuesday, July 14, 2020**. The hearing is entitled, “Oversight of DOE During the COVID-19 Pandemic.” The witness for this hearing will be the Hon. Dan Brouillette, Secretary of the U.S. Department of Energy.

This hearing will take place both in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building, as well as remotely via the Committee’s Cisco Webex online video conferencing.
