- To establish in law the mission of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to protect public health and safety, promote the common defense and security, protect the environment, and improve the general welfare, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "NRC Mission Align-
 - 5 ment Act".

1	SEC. 2. IMPROVING THE GENERAL WELFARE AND LICENS-
