Add at the end the following:

1	SEC OFFICE OF PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT.
2	(a) In General.—Not later than 1 year after the
3	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-
4	tation shall rename the Community Liaison Services with-
5	in the Office of Pipeline Safety of the Pipeline and Haz-
6	ardous Materials Safety Administration as the Office of
7	Public Engagement (hereinafter in this section referred to
8	as the "Office").
9	(b) Duties.—The duties of the Office are to—
10	(1) proactively engage with pipeline stake-
11	holders, including the public, pipeline operators,
12	public safety organizations, and government officials,
13	to raise awareness of pipeline safety practices;
14	(2) promote the adoption and increased use of
15	safety programs and activities;
16	(3) inform the public of pipeline safety regula-
17	tions and best practices; and

1	(4) assist the public with inquiries regarding
2	pipeline safety.
3	(c) Public Access.—The Office shall ensure that
4	activities carried out by the Office and information prod-
5	ucts developed by the Office are accessible to the public.
6	(d) Community Liaisons.—The Office shall incor-
7	porate positions known as "community liaisons" under the
8	Community Liaison Services.
9	(e) Report.—Not later than 18 months after the
10	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-
11	tation shall submit to Congress a report on the implemen-
12	tation of this section.
