1	SEC WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT.
2	(a) Additional Full-time Equivalent Employ-
3	EES.—In addition to the personnel level authorized for the
4	Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration
5	as of the date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator
6	of such Administration may increase the number of full-
7	time equivalent employees in the Office of Pipeline Safety
8	by not more than 30 positions for employees who have
9	advanced engineering, scientific, or other technical exper-
10	tise (or equivalent experience) to—
11	(1) develop and implement pipeline safety poli-
12	cies and regulations; and
13	(2) fulfill congressional rulemaking mandates.
14	(b) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 1 year after
15	the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-
16	portation shall submit to Congress a report on—

1	(1) any progress made on implementation of
2	subsection (a);
3	(2) the implementation of the recruitment and
4	retention incentives authorized in section 102 of the
5	PIPES Act of 2020 (49 U.S.C. 60101 note);
6	(3) barriers and challenges to hiring and reten-
7	tion at the Administration;
8	(4) staffing levels of inspection and enforcement
9	personnel of the Administration; and
10	(5) any additional workforce needs of the Ad-
11	ministration.
12	(c) Effect on Existing Regulation.—Section
13	102(c) of the PIPES Act of 2020 (49 U.S.C. 60101 note)
14	is amended by striking paragraph (3) and inserting the
15	following:
16	"(3) Effect on existing regulation.—In
17	implementing the incentives described in paragraph
18	(1), the Secretary, in consultation with the Adminis-
19	trator of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safe-
20	ty Administration, may waive existing regulations.".
