## 1 SEC. 4. PURPOSE AND GENERAL AUTHORITY.

- 2 (a) Worker and Public Safety.—Section 60102
- 3 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by adding at
- 4 the end the following:
- 5 "(u) WORKER AND PUBLIC SAFETY.—
- 6 "(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall estab-
- 7 lish a zone, referred to in this section as a 'Worker
- 8 and Public Safety Zone', at the location of any pipe-
- 9 line construction or pipeline repair operation for the
- purpose of providing notice of the distance the gen-
- eral public shall maintain from pipeline workers and
- the activities of such workers.
- 13 "(2) REQUIREMENTS.—In establishing a Work-
- er and Public Safety Zone described in paragraph
- 15 (1), the Secretary shall—

1	"(A) establish such a Zone around any
2	pipeline construction and pipeline repair oper-
3	ations that exists during pipeline construction
4	or repairs and within which only owner-operator
5	authorized personnel, including contractors and
6	subcontractors, shall be permitted;
7	"(B) ensure that such a Zone—
8	"(i) exists at all times during pipeline
9	construction or pipeline repairs;
10	"(ii) does not exist after pipeline con-
11	struction or pipeline repairs are completed;
12	"(iii) does not apply to local distribu-
13	tion systems and intrastate transmission
14	pipelines; and
15	"(iv) posts a notice that includes the
16	safety purpose of such a Zone at the loca-
17	tion of pipeline construction and repairs;
18	and
19	"(C) establish a reasonable standard of
20	safe distance from pipeline construction and re-
21	pairs workers and the activities of such workers
22	for the notice under subparagraph (B)(iv).
23	"(3) CIVIL PENALTY.—
24	"(A) In general.—Any unauthorized in-
25	dividual entering a Worker and Public Safety

1	Zone established pursuant to this subsection
2	shall be liable to the United States for a civil
3	penalty for each violation.
4	"(B) Amount.—The Secretary shall deter-
5	mine the amount of such penalty using the con-
6	siderations under section 60122(b).
7	"(4) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in
8	this subsection shall be construed to amend, alter or
9	effect—
10	"(A) the authorities of the Secretary under
11	this chapter or parts 192 or 195 of title 49,
12	Code of Federal Regulations; or
13	"(B) a landowner's rights.".
14	(b) REGULATION REQUIRED.—Not later than 1 year
15	after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
16	Transportation shall issue a final rule establishing a pro-
17	cedure and requirements for carrying out section
18	60102(u) of title 49, United States Code.
