Whitney Muse is the President of Muse Energy LLC, which provides consulting services on energy policy, implementation, and supply chain topics.

During the Biden administration, she served as the Chief of Staff at the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Electricity, then established a brand-new office, the Grid Deployment Office, as Chief of Staff and Senior Advisor. She led the program design and implementation of the nation's largest investment in grid resilience. She later served as a Senior Policy Advisor for the White House Office of Clean Energy Innovation and Implementation, where she oversaw \$140+ billion in clean energy funding from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act and Inflation Reduction Act.

Prior to federal service, she was a manager in Deloitte's federal energy practice, where she provided policy and regulatory analysis of domestic and international power sector projects. She also worked at the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners implementing capacity-building programs for energy regulators around the world.

She received her B.S. in Engineering from Rutgers University and M.A. in International Energy and Environment Policy from Johns Hopkins University, School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS).
