Re: Proposed Disclosure of Code Name Dr. Administrator's Transcript

Dear Chairwoman Blackburn and Representative Schakowsky:

I write as individual counsel on behalf of my client, Code Name Dr. Administrator, to strongly urge the Select Panel against further public disclosures of my client's identity. By virtue of placing her name on the Select Panel's website in connection with the upcoming business meeting, she has been put in real jeopardy yet again. The Select Panel is well aware of the deadly violence that took place in our neighboring state of Colorado, and is also well aware that this physician has personally experienced threats and harassment both at home and work. Thus, any decision to identify her by name is indistinguishable, in effect, from encouraging similar or even more grave and violent conduct. Since there simply can be no legitimate purpose in disclosing this physician's identity that outweighs her and her family's safety, the only right act is to stop the disclosures, now.

For these reasons as well those set forth in Mr. Ryan's letter of today's date on behalf of the University of New Mexico, I request that the Select Panel mitigate the damage already done by redacting Dr. Administrator's name from any present and all future disclosures of information made public.
