Scott Gottlieb, MD is a practicing physician and Resident Fellow at the American Enterprise Institute. From 2005-2007, Dr. Gottlieb served as FDA Deputy Commissioner for Medical and Scientific Affairs and before that, from 2003-2004, as a senior advisor to the FDA Commissioner and as the FDA's Director of Medical Policy Development. He left FDA in the spring of 2004 to work on implementation of the new Medicare Drug Benefit as a Senior Adviser

to the Administrator of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. Dr. Gottlieb is an editorial board member of the journal Value Based Cancer Care, the Food and Drug Law Institute's Policy Forum, and is a member of the board of advisers of Cancer Commons. He writes a regular column for the Wall Street Journal. Dr. Gottlieb is a member of the policy boards to the Society of Hospitalist Medicine and the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society and serves as a director to public and private life science and healthcare services companies. Dr. Gottlieb is a Clinical Assistant Professor at the New York University School of Medicine. He completed a residency in internal medicine at the Mount Sinai Hospital in New York and is a graduate of the Mount Sinai School of Medicine and of Wesleyan University, in Middletown, Connecticut, where he studied Economics.
