Re: Subcommittee Markup

On Monday, July 28, 2014, at 3:00 p.m. in 2123 Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Health will meet in an open markup session on H.R. ____, a bill to require the Secretary of Health and Human Services to provide for recommendations for the development and use of clinical data registries for the improvement of patient care (Committee Print). In addition, the Subcommittee will take up H.R.4067, a bill to provide for the extension of the enforcement instruction on supervision requirements for outpatient therapeutic services in critical access and small rural hospitals through 2014.

In keeping with Chairman Upton's announced policy, Members must submit any amendments they may have two hours before they are offered during this markup. Any information with respect to an amendment's parliamentary standing (e.g., its germaneness) should be submitted at this time as well.

I. LEGISLATION

A. H.R. 4067: With an eye on rural access health care issues, the legislation would continue to delay for the remainder of 2014 the enforcement instruction regarding supervision requirements for outpatient therapeutic services offered in critical access and small rural hospitals.

B. Committee Print: The legislation would require the Secretary to publish specific recommendations for the development of clinical data registries.
