

Biography of Scott Faber

Scott Faber is the Senior Vice President of Government Affairs for EWG, a national environmental health organization. He joined EWG in 2012, and has since led EWG's efforts to reform farm, food and chemical safety policies. Faber also manages Just Label It, a coalition of more than 700 businesses and organizations dedicated to mandatory GMO labeling.

From 2007 to 2012, Faber was Vice President for Government Affairs for the Grocery Manufacturers Association, where he led GMA's efforts to enact the Food Safety Modernization Act.

From 2000 to 2007, Faber was a campaign manager for the Environmental Defense Fund, where he led efforts to reform farm policies and to restore the Mississippi and Missouri rivers.

Faber has frequently served as an expert on farm, food, renewable fuel, and water policies. Faber holds a J.D. from Georgetown University Law Center.
