Linda Greenstein was elected to the New Jersey Senate in a November 2010 special election and is serving her second full Senate term. She served for six terms in the New Jersey General Assembly, a tenure that began in January 2000.

Senator Greenstein is the first woman to represent the 14th Legislative District in the Senate.

A fulltime Legislator, Senator Greenstein serves as Assistant Majority Leader of the State Senate as well as Chair of Law and Public Safety and Vice-Chairwoman of the Environment and Energy Committee. She is a member of the Budget and Appropriations Committee and was appointed to the New Jersey Legislative Select Committee on Investigation, a bipartisan, joint panel investigating the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey.

In the Assembly, she served as Deputy Speaker, Assistant Majority Leader and was chair of the Judiciary Committee.

Senator Greenstein was educated at Vassar College, Johns Hopkins University, and the Georgetown University Law Center and is a specialist in disability law. Prior to becoming a legislator, she was a Senior Staff Attorney at the Community Health Law Project and served as a Deputy Attorney General in the Division of Criminal Justice in Trenton and as an Assistant District Attorney in Philadelphia. She was also a clinical associate professor at Seton Hall Law School.

Linda is married to Michael Greenstein and they are parents of a son, Evan.
