3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicaid and CHIP  
5 Territory Fraud Prevention Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCING MEDICAID AND CHIP FRAUD IN THE**  
2 **TERRITORIES OF THE UNITED STATES.**

3 Section 1108(g)(4) of the Social Security Act (42  
4 U.S.C. 1308(g)(4)) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “and (4)” and inserting “and  
6 (5)”; and

7 (2) by adding at the end the following: “With  
8 respect to fiscal years beginning with fiscal year  
9 2016, if Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam, the  
10 Northern Mariana Islands, or American Samoa  
11 qualify for a payment under paragraph (6) of sec-  
12 tion 1903(a) for a calendar quarter of such fiscal  
13 year, the payment shall not be taken into account in  
14 applying subsection (f) (as increased in accordance  
15 with paragraphs (1), (2), (3), and (5) of this sub-  
16 section) to such commonwealth or territory for such  
17 fiscal year.”.
