A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF WAIVER AUTHORITY RE-**
2 **GARDING PACE PROGRAMS.**

5 1903(m)(2)(A)(iii)” and inserting “1903(m)(2)(A)(iii),
6 and 1934 (other than subsections (b)(1)(A) and (c)(5) of
7 such section)”.
