3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Medicaid Requiring
5	Expenditures for Public Objectives to be Reflective of

6 Total Spending Act" or the "Medicaid REPORTS Act".

1	SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR STATES TO SUBMIT REPORTS
2	ON SOURCES OF FUNDS USED TO FINANCE
3	THE NON-FEDERAL SHARE OF MEDICAID.
4	(a) In General.—Section 1903(w)(6) of the Social
5	Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396b(w)(6)) is amended by add-
6	ing at the end the following new subparagraphs:
7	"(C) The Secretary shall require each State to submit
8	a report, at least once during 2016 and each year there-
9	after, using formats and standards established and up-
10	dated as necessary by the Secretary, identifying each
11	source of funds specified in subparagraph (D) (and the
12	amount of funds from each such source) used by the State
13	to finance the non-Federal share of expenditures under
14	this title for such year. Such report also shall—
15	"(i) identify each entity providing the funds
16	used by the State to finance the non-Federal share
17	of expenditures under this title; and
18	"(ii) provide such additional information as the
