## **I. INTRODUCTION**

On Wednesday, June 8, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. in XXXX Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Health will meet in open markup session to consider the following:

- H.R. 921, Sports Medicine Licensure Act; and
- H.R. 3299, Strengthening Public Health Emergency Response Act.

In keeping with Chairman Upton's announced policy, Members must submit any amendments they may have two hours before they are offered during this markup. Any information with respect to an amendment's parliamentary standing (e.g., its germaneness) should be submitted at this time as well.

## **II. LEGISLATION**

- A. H.R. 921, Sports Medicine Licensure Act, authored by Vice Chairman Guthrie (R-KY), this legislation would ensure that sports medicine professionals are properly covered by their malpractice insurance while traveling with athletic teams in another State.
- B. H.R. 3299, Strengthening Public Health Emergency Response Act. authored by Reps. Brooks (R-IN) and Eshoo (D-CA) would increase American emergency preparedness by increasing administrative efficiency within the Office of Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR) in the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and provide incentives for companies to spur development of medical countermeasures for public health emergencies and biochemical attacks.
