

Mr. Morris leads the agency's work evaluating a broad spectrum of food safety and agriculture issues. In this role, Steve has led numerous reviews examining the federal government's efforts to ensure a safe food supply for consumers, address the impacts of agriculture on the environment, and provide an adequate financial safety net for farmers. Prior to his appointment in NRE, Steve served as an Assistant Director with GAO's Homeland Security and Justice team where he provided leadership examining the Department of Homeland Security's efforts to secure the nation's transportation system. His work helped to shape legislation and public policy in several key areas of aviation security, most notably in air cargo. He joined GAO in 1990 as an evaluator in the Atlanta Regional Office. Mr. Morris holds a bachelor's degree in Sociology and Anthropology, and a master's degree in International Studies from Florida International University.
