9	"(5) Parent mentor.—The term 'parent
10	mentor' means an individual who—
11	"(A) is a parent or guardian of at least
12	one child who is an eligible child under this title
13	or title XIX; and
14	"(B) is trained to assist families with chil-
15	dren who have no health insurance coverage
16	with respect to improving the social deter-

1	minants of the health of such children, includ-
2	ing by providing—
3	"(i) education about health insurance
4	coverage, including, with respect to obtain-
5	ing such coverage, eligibility criteria and
6	application and renewal processes;
7	"(ii) assistance with completing and
8	submitting applications for health insur-
9	ance coverage;
10	"(iii) a liaison between families and
11	representatives of State plans under title
12	XIX or State child health plans under this
13	title;
14	"(iv) guidance on identifying medical
15	and dental homes and community phar-
16	macies for children; and
17	"(v) assistance and referrals to suc-
18	cessfully address social determinants of
19	children's health, including poverty, food
20	insufficiency, and housing.".
