MATTHEW EYLES

Matthew (Matt) Eyles is Senior Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer at America's Health Insurance Plans (AHIP), the national trade association representing the health insurance industry. He also leads the Policy & Regulatory Affairs team at AHIP, which has responsibility for policy development for government programs (Medicare, Medicaid), commercial and employer-sponsored plans, state policy and cross-cutting issues, such as pharmaceuticals. Matt joined AHIP in January 2015 from the consulting firm, Avalere Health.

Previously, Matt held senior executive roles at Coventry Health Care, Inc. (now an Aetna company) where he was responsible for policy, government affairs, and corporate communications and at Wyeth (now Pfizer, Inc.) where he led worldwide policy for its pharmaceutical, consumer health, and animal health divisions.
