

SUMMARY OF QUALIFICATIONS:

Dr. Logan has been a community practice pharmacist since 1975, owning two pharmacies in Southeast Missouri. Additionally, he is a recently retired drug diversion investigator for the Mississippi County, Missouri Sheriff's Department.

Since 1994 he served as a certified police officer in the state of Missouri. Much of that time was spent with the Scott-Mississippi Prescription Abuse Task Force. Dr. Logan has taught officers techniques of drug diversion investigation, and has strived to raise awareness of prescription drug abuse in Missouri.

Dr. Logan has also served nationally with the Pharmacy Quality Alliance to develop medication use measures around opioids.
