SUMMARY OF QUALIFICATIONS

Dr. Rachel Cumberbatch is the Director of Regulatory Affairs, Animal Drug Section at the Animal Health Institute (AHI). AHI represents the manufacturers of animal drugs and veterinary biologics before federal agencies, Congress, and international health and food safety organizations.

Dr. Cumberbatch began her career as a clinical veterinarian and transitioned to public policy in 2013 when she was selected as a AAAS Science Policy Fellow at the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. She later served as an American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) Congressional Fellow supporting Senator Al Franken's healthcare portfolio. During her tenure in the Senate, Dr. Cumberbatch advised the senator throughout the Zika virus outbreak and worked to improve public health infrastructure by raising the profile of One Health – the intersection between animal, human, and environmental health.

Dr. Cumberbatch earned her Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM) in 2011 and Bachelor of Science in Animal Sciences in 2007, both from Purdue University. During her educational career, Dr. Cumberbatch was named Purdue University Outstanding Senior Women, delivered the 2011 commencement student response, and was appointed by Governor Mitch Daniels to serve as a Purdue University Student Trustee.

Dr. Cumberbatch currently serves as the President of the DC Veterinary Medical Association.
